**UPDATED NOTICE
REGARDING COVID-19**

April 23, 2020

The Potter Stewart Courthouse in Cincinnati, Ohio has been temporarily closed by order of the United States District Court. A copy of the order is available on their website.

The Clerk's Office of the Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals will continue to process all electronically received documents, but due to the closure the court will NOT be able to process incoming mail or accept deliveries until further notice. The court will also see delays and disruption to outgoing mail. No checks or money orders should be forwarded to the Clerk's Office, and no credit card payments can be accepted via telephone until further notice.

Chief Judge R. Guy Cole, Jr. has issued an order extending most deadlines for pro se filers who must file by mail. A copy of the Order may be found on the court's website.

All remote arguments scheduled for April 27-May 8, 2020 **will** go forward as scheduled.

The temporary suspension of the requirement that pro se litigants file exclusively in paper format is extended to include prisoners, but this allowance does not require any institution to provide the means for electronic filing to prisoners.
