**SIXTH CIRCUIT ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT OF FIRST DIRECTOR OF  
WORKPLACE RELATIONS**

CINCINNATI (May 8, 2020)- Chief Judge R. Guy Cole, Jr. of the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit is pleased to announce the appointment of Kelly J. Roseberry as the Sixth Circuit's Director of Workplace Relations.

Ms. Roseberry will provide leadership in the development and implementation of the workplace relations program for federal courts within the Sixth Circuit, which include the Court of Appeals, and federal district and bankruptcy courts and related court units in Kentucky, Michigan, Ohio, and Tennessee. The Director of Workplace Relations will create a circuit-wide workplace relations office that will oversee the implementation of employment dispute resolution policies, facilitate resolution of workplace issues, provide trainings to foster healthy workplace environments, and will be available to assist all judges and court staff.

Ms. Roseberry comes to the Sixth Circuit after a successful 10 years in Wyoming state government, where she most recently served as Interim Administrator for their Workforce Standards Division while concurrently serving as the Deputy Administrator for Labor Standards and the Executive Secretary for the Wyoming Medical Commission. In these roles, Ms. Roseberry gained experience directing the oversight and enforcement of state and federal labor laws including Title VII, ADA, ADEA, and FLSA, among others. She also oversaw and conducted workplace trainings for hundreds of employees each year. Ms. Roseberry's experience also includes serving as an Administrative Hearing Officer, where she was directly responsible for mediating and resolving employment conflicts.

Prior to these roles, Ms. Roseberry served in the Wyoming Attorney General's Office as an attorney in its Civil Division and Litigation Division, and as a Staff Attorney with a law firm. Ms. Roseberry received her bachelor's degree from Vanderbilt University and Juris Doctor from the University of Kentucky. She also holds certifications as a Mediator and Public Manager.

Scheduled to assume her new duties on May 18, 2020, Ms. Roseberry will work within the Office of the Circuit Executive.
