

Admission to the Potter Stewart Courthouse

All persons entering the courthouse will be required to walk through security and show a photo ID.

All belongings will be required to pass through an x-ray machine and are subject to a search.

The following items are strictly prohibited:

- Firearms
- Explosives
- Pepper spray
- Incendiary devices
- Knives
- Any other item prohibited by law, regulation or court order

Any person refusing to submit to this screening process will be denied access to the courthouse.

Technology

No cameras or recording devices are permitted unless authorized by a Judge of the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit, a Judge of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Ohio, the Circuit Executive for the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit, the Clerk of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Ohio, or their authorized representatives.

The use of portable computers and related electronic equipment in courtrooms and facilities adjacent to courtrooms is subject to restrictions imposed by a judicial officer in connection with a case pending before that judicial officer.

The use of cellular phones in chambers or courtrooms is *prohibited* unless specifically authorized by the judicial officer presiding therein.

Cell phones may be used in the public hallways so long as such use does not disrupt courtroom or other official proceedings.
