ORDER EXTENDING CERTAIN CASE MANAGEMENT PLAN DEADLINES

This matter is before the Special Master on the State of Mississippi's Unopposed Motion for Extension of Certain Case Management Plan Deadlines, and the Special Master, having duly considered same, finds that the Motion is well taken and should be granted. Accordingly, the Case Management Plan is amended to provide as follows: the parties shall exchange opening expert reports, if any, by June 30, 2017; the parties shall exchange rebuttal expert reports, if any, by July 31, 2017; all discovery shall be completed by August 31, 2017; and by September 29, 2017, the parties shall submit a joint proposed order that sets forth a plan for the

hearing and any pre-or-post-hearing briefing. The Case Management Plan remains the same in all other respects.
