CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND POST-TRIAL BRIEFING**



This cause came to be heard upon the Joint Motion of Plaintiff and Defendants for a two-week extension to the deadline for filing proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law and post-hearing briefs. For the reasons set out in the Joint Motion, the Special Master finds that the Motion is well taken and should be granted.

**IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED,** that Section IV(A) of the Corrected Pre-Hearing Scheduling Order (Doc. 69) be amended as follows:

- A. No later than Thursday, September 5, 2019, the parties shall file:
  1. Proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law (with citations to the record); and

2. Post-hearing briefs that summarize each party's argument. Post-hearing briefs shall be limited to 40 pages.
