## CONSENT ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION FOR A TWO-WEEK EXTENSION TO FILE PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND POST-TRIAL BRIEFING

2. Post-hearing briefs that summarize each party's argument. Post-hearing briefs shall be limited to 40 pages.
